Refrigerator & Freezer

- O Remove all food and discard expired items
- O Wipe down shelves, drawers, and walls
- O Clean and deodorize with baking soda
- O Vacuum the coils behind the fridge

Oven & Stovetop

- O Deep clean oven interior (use self-cleaning mode or baking soda paste)
- O Remove and scrub oven racks
- O Wipe down stovetop and burner grates Clean range hood and filter

Microwave & Small Appliances

- O Wipe down the microwave interior and exterior
- O Clean the toaster crumb tray
- O Descale the coffee maker
- O Wipe down the blender, air fryer, and any other frequently used appliances

Cabinets & Drawers

- O Declutter and wipe down cabinet interiors
- Organize pantry and discard expired items
- O Wipe down and polish cabinet doors

Sink & Dishwasher

- O Scrub and disinfect the sink and drain
- O Clean garbage disposal (use lemon and baking soda)
- O Run an empty dishwasher cycle with vinegar

Countertops & Backsplash

- O Scrub and disinfect surfaces
- O Polish stone countertops (if applicable)

Windows & Walls

- Wipe down walls and remove grease splatters
- O Clean window sills and blinds
- O Wash or replace curtains

Floors & Baseboards

- O Scrub grout and deep clean tile (if applicable)
- O Wipe down baseboards

- O Clean light fixtures and ceiling fan

Washer & Dryer

- O Run a cleaning cycle in the washer (vinegar & baking soda work great!)
- O Wipe the inside of the washer drum and door seal
- O Clean dryer vent and exhaust to prevent lint buildup
- O Check hoses and filters for clogs or leaks

Shelving & Storage

- O Declutter and toss expired or empty laundry products
- O Wipe down shelves and reorganize supplies
- O Store seasonal clothing and linens properly

Floors & Surfaces

- O Mop floors and clean baseboards
- Wipe down walls and remove dust from behind appliances

Windows & Floors


- O Wash windows and clean window sills
- O Dust or vacuum curtains and blinds
- O Sweep, vacuum, or mop floors
- O Clean baseboards and remove scuff marks

Miscellaneous

Before you Start

- O Gather Supplies Grab a vacuum, microfiber cloths, all-purpose cleaner, and vinegar for appliance cleaning.
